## Weather Resilience Plan for Caunton

### Introduction

The weather resilience plan aims to reduce the risk of injury or damage to people and property

### Residents' responsibility

- Residents should prepare a personal plan
- Residents should ensure they have adequate insurance
- Residents should be familiar with the weather resilience plan
- Residents should be familiar with the contact details provided in the plan
- Residents should be familiar with the information sources provided in the plan
- Residents should be aware of their responsibilities for maintaining watercourses on their land

### The Plan

The plan has four distinct parts

1. Reducing the risk
2. Responding
3. Recovery
4. Contacts and Information

The implementation of the plan will be facilitated by trained wardens

The plan will be available to residents as printed copies available from the Parish Council and on the Parish Council Website

#### 1. Reducing the Risk

Residents and wardens should be observant of blockages to water courses and drains

- Keep The Beck clear of obstructions
- Keep drainage ditches clear of obstructions
- Maintain watercourses and culverts on private land
- Ensure drains on the highways are not blocked
- Keep and maintain the resilience store within the village

#### 2. Responding

The location of the resilience store is: The Car Park, Dean Hole School, Manor Road

### Warnings

The decision to implement the plan will be taken by the wardens and will depend upon four sources of warning

- Observation of the level of The Beck
- General warnings issued by the Met office

- Local weather conditions
- Warnings received by wardens registered with the Environment Agency

Once it has been determined that there is a likelihood of high water levels the wardens will:

- Assemble at the ford to assess the situation on the ground
- Recruit additional help
- If necessary warn residents at risk by telephone or visiting their house
- Assist vulnerable residents
- Assist residents with moving defence materials from the resilience store to the areas most at risk
- Notify and assist the local authorities
- Establish a central meeting point in a safe and convenient building and agree a telephone contact number this point
- The plan does not include road closures.

Entering deep water is hazardous. Materials may be contaminated by sewage

### **3. Recovery**

- The emergency services, local authorities, wardens and residents should work together after an event and the emergency services will control access to the affected area
- Residents should familiarise themselves with the requirements of their insurance company should they need to make a claim
- Wardens are not responsible for clearing up and are not to handle materials that have been in contact with contaminated water
- Once the water has subsided the wardens will check water courses and report any blockages to the relevant authorities
- Wardens will restock the resilience shed

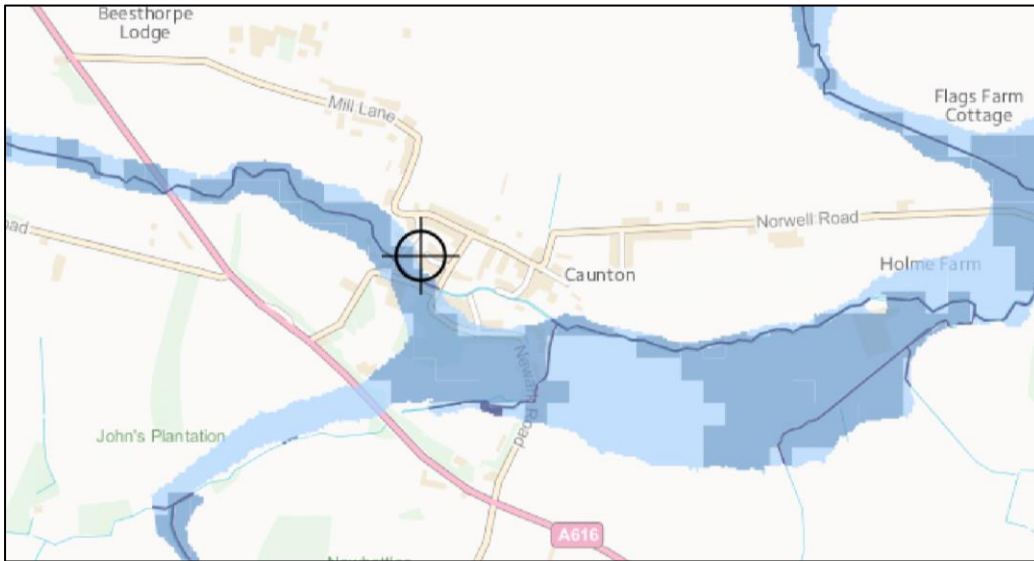

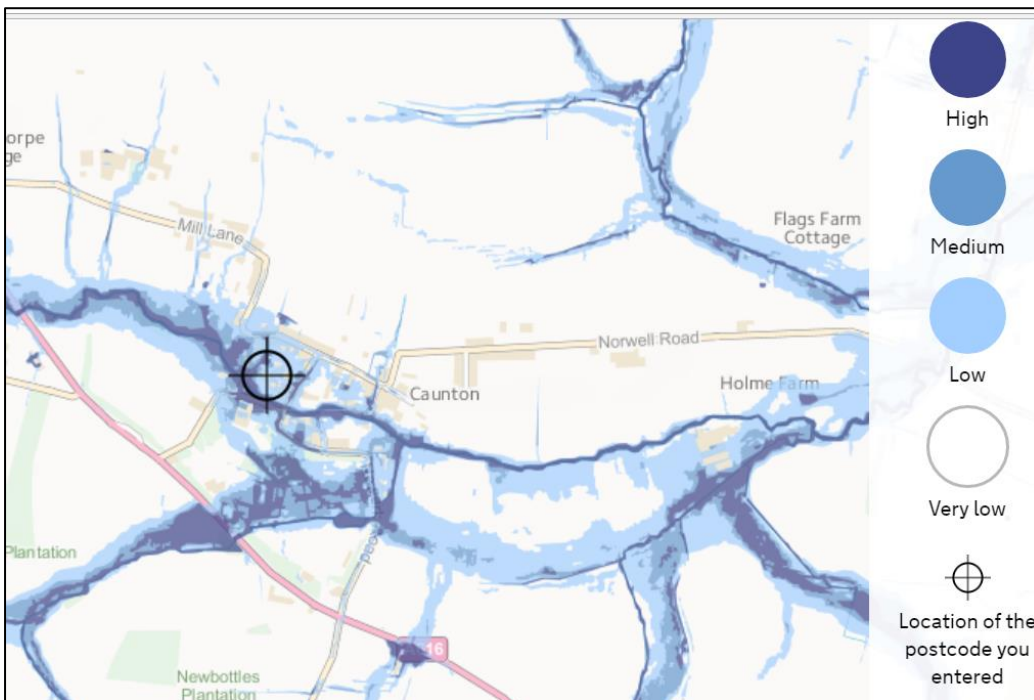
